

**COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT – DISASTER RECOVERY  
SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT NO. 3  
PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE**

The City was awarded \$25,080,000 in CDBG-DR funds to address the impact of the floods of 2015 on the affected neighborhoods through a Housing Program and an Infrastructure Program. The Owner-Occupied Housing Program of the CDBG-DR grant includes choosing an allowable method of determining applicant income eligibility for the program. Substantial Amendment No. 3 changes the method cited in the Action Plan from the *Section 8 – Part 5* method of income eligibility determination to the *IRS Adjusted Gross Income* method of income eligibility determination.

The Substantial Amendment No. 3 will be available for citizen review/comment beginning Friday, September 10, 2017 through September 25, 2017. Copies of the Amendment will be available at the City Planning & Development Services office and the Community Development Block Grant Office, both located at 630 E. Hopkins, San Marcos 78666.
